

## Guidelines for the 2024 Mowing Season

Bangor Housing Maintenance Team will be performing the mowing duties at all our properties. The following information will help us work together to accomplish this goal.

We will be mowing all properties on a weekly basis and will be doing our best to establish a predictable routine for the mowing and trimming of all areas. This schedule is dependent upon weather conditions and may be necessary to adjust the schedule as needed.

## Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday

Capehart, Greenfield, Splash Pad Area, BBR, 1613 Ohio St., Day Care, Administration, Maintenance

## **Thursday & Friday**

Crestwood Place, Autumn Park West, Nason Park, Birch Circle, Griffin Park, Griffin Square

## **Tenant Responsibilities**

- If you have a fenced area or shed, you will need to cut/trim inside and outside the fence area and around your shed, **please trim at least 2' from the items.**
- If you have outdoor items such as outdoor furniture, plant pots, play equipment, solar lights, lawn chairs, decorative items, you will need to mow/trim around all these items or simply move them out of the way on mowing day to allow us to mow the area.
- If you have intentional plantings such as shrubs, flowers, bushes, gardens, etc. you will need to surround them with landscaping edging or a small protective fence so they will not be accidentally mowed or trimmed by the Maintenance crew.
- If you have animals, you are responsible for removing feces from the area, the area will not be able to be mowed if it is not picked up.
- For safety reasons on mowing day, please stay clear and keep children, guests, and animals out of the area when the mowing and trimming is being performed.

If you have any questions regarding this seasons' mowing and trimming, please contact your Property Manager.

If for any reason the tenant responsibilities are not followed and we are not able to mow or trim your area, this could result in a Maintenance charge to you.
